Admissions Policy

St. Anselm Catholic School runs open enrollment during the school year and during the summer for students wanting to start school or move to SAS from another school. To be admitted, Preschool applicants must be 3 years old by September 1 of the current year. Pre-Kindergarten applicants must be 4 years old by September 1 of the current year. Kindergarten applicants must be 5 years old by September 1 of the current year and must schedule a time for Kindergarten testing prior to the start of the current school year. St. Anselm does not offer a waiver for early childhood education.

First grade students must complete an approved Kindergarten program prior to admittance.

Students in all programs and grade levels must partake in a religious education class, and must attend mass on Fridays at 8:30 am with our school community. Religion is a graded course at St. Anselm.

Transfer students *may* be academically tested to determine the appropriate grade level.
