It's the most wonderful time of the year! Advent and Christmas! We are very busy in the school, but our hallways and classrooms are filled with the excitement that December brings. I wish you a blessed Advent season.

I had mentioned this in an earlier school scope, but we now have a new latchkey coordinator. Her name is Miss Emily Matlak. She started this week and is full of energy and enthusiasm. Miss Matlak has graciously offered to run latchkey on half days of school. We have very few of those, but we do have a half day on Wednesday, December 21.
