Happy January and Happy New Year to everyone! I sincerely hope that you had a restful and enjoyable break with family and friends. Before we know it, we will be on to winter break! How time flies when we're having fun!

We are about to embark on a few important portions of the school year in the next few weeks.

On Friday, quarter 2 will close. Our teachers will have the weekend to put grades together and report cards should be live and on powerschool by Tuesday, January 17 or Wednesday, January 18. I will shut the grade aspect of powerschool down on Friday and it will be back up when report cards are live. Please be patient as many other schools are updating grades and report cards. There are sometimes issues with powerschool because of this. I will send a message when report cards are up.

As we cruise into the second half of the school year, now is the time to seriously think about what is working for your student(s) and what isn't. Here are some questions to ask about grades, conduct, and report cards:

- 1. Is my student organized with folders, binders, and books? Do the appropriate materials come home each night?
- 2. Is my student writing his/her assignments down in his/her planner each day? Are the assignments checked off when complete?
- 3. Where is my student completing homework and studying for tests? Are there distractions?
- 4. Who is checking to ensure that the work is done and put in the backpack before heading to school in the morning?
- 5. Am I checking powerschool on a weekly basis to see the grades in each class?
- 6. Do I communicate with my student's teacher (when necessary) and encourage my student to ask questions when clarification is needed?

If we seriously take a look at what may be causing low grades, we would notice that the culprit is probably missing assignments. Every person has to have a quiet place to work, and every student needs checking up on. If we partner to ensure that the students are being held accountable at school, and at home, we will see more success in our classes.

At the end of the month, we will celebrate *Catholic Schools Week*! This is a truly EXCITING time for our students and staff. We will kick the week off with our Open House on Sunday, January 29 from 1:00-3:00. We will need middle school student volunteers to give tours. If your student is interested, please have them let me know or you can call the office. Students should report at 12:45. I will be announcing our themes and dress up days in the next school scope. Be on the look out for that information!
