I hope all of you are having a good week. This weather is sure throwing everyone for a loop. I am constantly praying for some relief! I would really like spring to show up soon!

Here are some reminders from my desk:

Tomorrow, our 5th and 6th grade students will travel to DCES to participate in the Battle of the Books with the other schools in our vicariate. The following schools will participate: St. Anselm, Divine Child, St. Mary of Wayne, St. Sebastian, St. Linus, Sacred Heart, and St. Stephen in New Boston. This is the third year that we have participated and it is a great time for our children. They get to know students from other schools, who they may go to high school with. And, they get to step out of their comfort zone to work in groups and talk about the assigned books. Please ask your student about it when they get home-- I'm sure they will say very positive things!

As a reminder, we have out of uniform days every Monday until Easter, so at this point, we have four left. To be clear, these out of uniform days consist of jeans or sweats, a Stagwear top, and tennis shoes. Nothing else. Students can dress down only if they bring in \$1.00 to support the missions. We have many students "forgetting" to wear Stagwear and being written up. Please be sure to set out the right clothing.

Additionally, many of our students have earned detentions for tardies or behavior issues. Our next detention will be held on Friday, March 24. Detention is 45 minutes and is served with me (3-3:45). Our students take that time to clean up the building, and if the weather is nice, we clean up outside, too. They will not be sitting and reading, or doing homework. Thank you for your cooperation with this, and for working together to hold our children to a high standard.

Lastly, we have had some questions about the FACTS program and AOD financial aid. If you login into the FACTS system, you can find St. Anselm under "Dearborn" or "Dearborn Hts". If you search "Dearborn Heights," it will not come up. I have no idea why. I logged into the system today and was able to start the application with St. Anselm listed as my school. Again, if you have any questions, please let us know. Call the office or send me an email, and we can help. The application is due by April 7 and requires Monsignor's signature.
