I hope all of you are enjoying your week and enjoyed your day off this past Friday. Thank you to our volunteers who made the Card Party possible this past Sunday. The event was wellattended and a great time was had by all.

This week has been incredibly busy and it's only half way finished! March always seems to be quite eventful and this year is the same. Here are some updates and reminders as we head into fourth quarter.

The end of third quarter is Friday, March 24. Our teachers have to input grades and finalize them by Monday morning. If your student has not finished some work or needs to make anything up, he/she needs to do that immediately. Report Cards should be live on Powerschool by Wednesday, March 29, at the latest.

Also on Friday, we will have mass, stations of the cross, and an honors assembly for our current students of the month. All parents are welcome to come in and see their students be awarded for the months of February and March. Awards will take place around 9:30.

Detention will meet on Friday after school in the library. We will meet from 3:00-3:45. If your student has been given a detention notice, he/she will need to stay after. If he or she does not, their detention will carry over to the following week.

As we head into fourth quarter, I hope that our students take some time to set some goals for themselves. Maybe grades need to improve. Maybe organization needs to improve. What about independence or a skill set in a specific area? When I meet with students, I constantly tell them that no one can truly make them do anything to improve their behavior. They will have to answer for their behaviors and choices, and in life, they have to be accountable for their actions. We push this at school. We want our students to leave here ready to take on high school and move on to bigger challenges. I ask that you have a discussion (if needed) with your children. What are the goals that they want to accomplish? Short term and long term? And, what is a plan to get these goals met?

Lastly, I am always thinking about the next school year. All families will be informed of any changes for next year as we approach May, but you will soon receive a link for a school survey. I ask that parents/guardians take the time to complete this. It will only be two questions and I encourage you to answer completely and specifically. The only way we can improve is if we know what the concerns are. To follow, I would be happy to meet with any family who has concerns. You are welcome to email or call, and we can set up a time.
