Well, the hot weather is certainly upon us! Almost 90 this week. We can sure feel the school year inching toward the end. We still have lots to accomplish and I appreciate your help along the way!

My first reminder has to do with the paperwork that came home a couple of weeks ago. I included several items-- a scholarship form, a free and reduced lunch form, and a Moms and Dads club form. I need all of those returned as soon as possible-- at the very latest on June 8. I know that many of our families are constantly working to make ends meet and we want to help you in any way we can. I will review these items before we leave the office. Families will be notified in September of scholarships. Additionally, if you read my letter about free and reduced lunch, you will notice that we receive many benefits from the public school funds. Our students can be tutored, and receive books and technology. Filling out that form helps all parties. Thank you for your help!

To follow up from last week, and as a reminder, I made some changes to our calendar that were posted in our last school scope. We will have a half day on June 1 (11:30 dismissal). We will also end our school year on June 8 instead of June 9 with a 10:00 dismissal. By posting this last week, I have given all families almost a month to secure any childcare needed for those days. On June 1, we will continue to have latchkey until 6:00. We will not have latchkey on June 8.

When administrators design the calendar for the next school, usually about 6 months in advance, we schedule in extra time in case we have to take days off for severe weather or power outages. I always schedule more time than I have to, to be safe. I am very thankful that we have that time to use now to wind down the year. I don't anticipate any more changes to the calendar. As always, if you have any questions, you are welcome to call or email me.

Remember that tomorrow, after mass, we will honor our students of the month for May. I sent an email about those students earlier in the week. If your student is being honored and you would like to see them receive their certificate, please arrive at the church by 9:00. We will give out awards immediately following mass.

Lastly, thank you for all of your help with our fundraisers and donations for various reasons in the last few weeks. I realize that everything fell around the same time and we have discussed that this will not happen in the same manner, next school year. With Easter being late, many plans were pushed back to May. I appreciate your flexibility. The St. Anselm community is very generous and the many organizations we have helped are so grateful for us.
