This is it! Our last scope! We have two short weeks coming up. So, we don't need a full newsletter at the end of the year.

I know this time of the year is really busy. I suggest that you and your student take a look grades right now. The students have two more weeks to get everything together and turn in any missing work. Instead of waiting until the last day of school, the work needs to be completed now.
