The end of this week marks the half way point through quarter 2. Progress reports will be updated by Monday, December 4. As I have been looking through students' grades and visiting classrooms, I have noticed improvement with many students. However, the improvements come with organization. The students have one folder for completed work and one for incomplete work. The teachers collect the folders to grade the work. Planners are filled out in each class. I can say with the utmost certainty that every teacher in our building has assignments, assessment dates, and goals on their boards every day.
